Summer 2021 Program Details



The Cisco High School STEM Program is a comprehensive **2 week unpaid virtual summer externship** designed to give top, STEM and business focused students an introduction to Cisco's **history, culture, and the technology industry**.
Students will be engaged in **interactive project work, problem-solving, and learn to communicate with industry professionals and peers.**

Workshops include:

- **Cybersecurity**
- **IoT Fundamentals**
- **Intro to Meraki Solutions**
- **Design Thinking**
- **History of Cisco**
- **Persuasive Presentation**
- **Intro to DevNet**
- **Personal Branding/ Professional Etiquette**

Students will...

1. Shadow Cisco employees in the student's **field of interest**
2. Work in **teams** under the guidance of professional mentors to **creatively solve a business problem**
3. Participate in a day-long **Innovation Challenge** (Hackathon-style)
4. Participate in **team-building** and development activities
5. Compete in a final project related to **Internet of Things (IoT)**
6. Receive **school credit**, where possible

Curriculum

- 50%** IoT Projects
- 30%** Training Workshops
- 20%** Mentors, Job Shadow & Exec Speakers

Eligibility Requirements:

- Current **junior** or **senior** (Graduating in 2021 or 2022)
- Minimum **3.0 GPA**, either weighted or unweighted
- Demonstrable interest in **Business** and/or **Technology**
- Ability to **work virtually** Monday through Friday

A complete application includes:

- ✓ 1 letter of recommendation (academic)
- ✓ High school transcript (official or unofficial)
- ✓ Resume
- ✓ Video cover letter
